## Background



Fairbanks International School of Communication of Asia-Pacific Nazarene Theological Seminary has projected the goals of formal and non-formal education. In addition to the goals, FISC also seeks creative partnership with regional communication schools to provide service to educate future media professionals and media-minded pastors as well as missionaries.

The Asia-Pacific Global Communication (APGC) program intends to provide the cross-cultural exposure for Nazarene Young Leaders. In communicating in the multi-cultural context, English becomes the global language to learn. In addition, higher education emphasizes the social responsibility of future leaders. This program also provides community service opportunities to work to build Asian communities.

Based on the first pilot program in 2009, this second year program will be surely a great cross-cultural opportunity to provide the quality leadership program in cross-cultural context, to demonstrate Christian presence, and to outreach the holiness message to a group of Korean students.

## Expected Outcome/Benefits



Living amidst the multi-cultural community of Asia-Pacific Nazarene Theological Seminary the students will be able to:

- Understand the diverse cultures of the Philippines. Since the Filipino culture is intermingled with both western and eastern culture, it will be a good soil to understand multi-cultural aspects of the Asia region.
- Experience cross-cultural communication in a multi-cultural setting. The small but loving community will provide new cultural experience for young Korean Nazarene leaders.
- Take a communication course outside of Korean context to demonstrate communicative competence.
- Learn the importance of communicative aspects of English which stimulates their learning.
- Understand the importance of community service for making a global community. They will also be able to understand a serving heart as one of the most important elements for building the future of the Asian community.
