The PhD in Transformational Learning is designed to assist a new generation of faculty & educational leaders as they develop teaching, learning & leading approaches that result in transformational learning in diverse persons, institutions & cultures, of particular interest to those interested in preparing to teach or provide educational leadership in colleges, seminaries or other faith based organizations.



PhD in Transformational Learning

Degree Plan (60 units)

Students are invited to participate in a rich multicultural community to learn from one another and with professors who are well qualified to facilitate the transformational learning process. Courses will be offered in 2-week modules in January - March & May - July with courses being offered in a 3-year cycle.

AGST/APNTS PhD Degrees

The PhD in Transformational Learning is one of three doctoral degrees of the Asia Graduate School of Theology (AGST) being hosted in APNTS. AGST is a consortium of eight seminaries in the Philippines. The other parallel APNTS degrees are the PhD in Holistic Child Development & the PhD in Transformational Development.
